THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

ATTIRE:

- Day: Site visits Casual, comfortable dress/pants with comfortable walking shoes
- Evening: Resort casual

CURRENCY:

The local currency is the Jamaican Dollar, however the US Dollar is widely accepted throughout the country. The rate of exchange currently is J\$156.34: US\$1 (This may vary store to store). You are able to get US\$ and Jamaican\$ cash from the ATM machines located at the airport or hotels.

<u>Immigration/Customs: (Very important)</u>

Before you board your flight to Jamaica, go to: Enterjamaica.com and complete your immigration Customs C5 card. It's just one less thing you have to do when you arrive at the airport.

Only cost:

We welcome you as our guest(s), and the trip is complimentary. However, any incidental costs such as laundry, dry cleaning, valet charges, telephone calls, bar bills, room service and other charges of a personal nature is the responsibility of the individual.

Gratuities:

All gratuities for scheduled functions appearing on the itinerary are complimentary. You are requested to tip your airport porter if used.

Climate:

Jamaica averages a temperature of 85F all year. Evenings may cool to anywhere between 75F-80F
